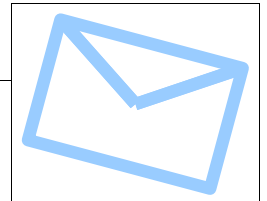
Editor's Corner

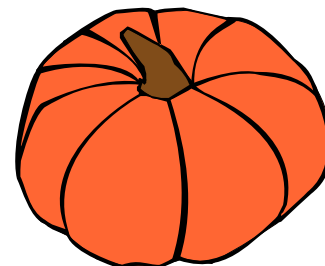

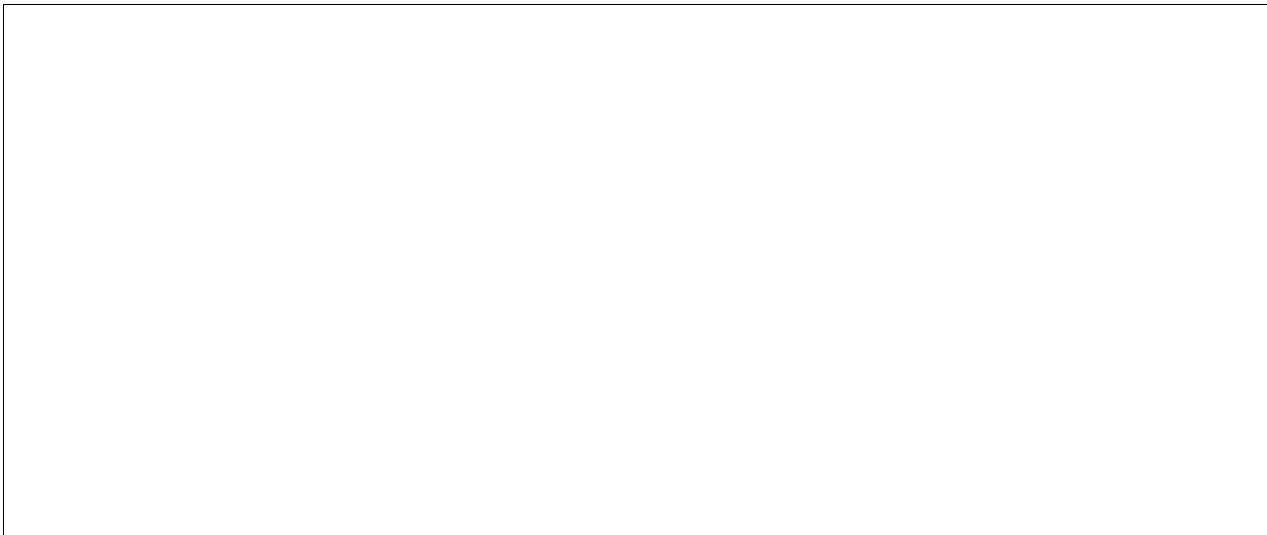
